1. INTRODUCTION TO SOCIETY AND COLLEGE

The Tapti Education Society was established long back in 1958 with the philanthropist view to provide higher education to the students from rural area. The society comprises mostly farmers and businessmen. Currently it is led by Hon.Mr. Mohanbhau Phalak as the President; Hon.Mr. Maheshbhau Phalak as the Chairman; Hon.Mr. Vishnubhau Chaudhari as the Secretary; Hon.Mr. Sanjayji Nahata as the treasurer along with respected members from the city.

The Society established the college in 1963 with two faculties namely Arts and Commerce. In 1972 the Science faculty was started. The college has its own land of nearly 7 acres near Asian Highway and Jamner Road crossing. Since its inception the college is catering to the educational needs of students from rural area. The Tapti Education Society's Bhusawal Arts, Science and P. O. Nahata Commerce College was accredited as **four stars** in 2001 and reaccredited as '**A**' **Grade** with CGPA3.28 in 2008as the **first College** in North Maharashtra University jurisdiction. It is also the first college to volunteer for the third cycle of accreditation in the jurisdiction of the university. **It is a thing of pride for us that this year the college is accredited at A grade with 3.30 CGPA in third cycle. We are proud to say that we are first in the University Jurisdiction to achieve this honour.** It is also recognized by UGC as **College with Potential for Excellence**. Our institute is one of the renowned institutes in the adjoining area. We welcomed the upcoming students from rural areas who made remarkable progress and set their and college's image in society. Many of the students of this institute secure top position in various fields. This make us feel great.

Initially the college was affiliated to the Pune University, and got permanent affiliation in 1990.
