Institute Discipline

1. Students must carry their Identity Card on person when in the college premises and produce it on demand.

4. Regular attendance for Theory and Practical is must. In case the attendance is found less than 80% classes of theory, Practical and other activities he/she will not be allowed to appear for the University Examination.
5. Student should behave respectfully to the teaching and non-teaching staff within campus and outside College premises; otherwise they are liable for disciplinary action.
6. Students must pay stipulated fees within the given time span.

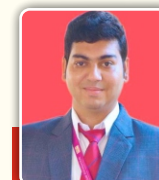

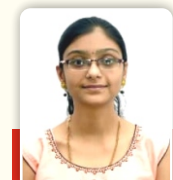

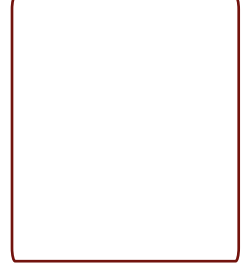
